ABOUT THE SOCIETY

The Society is open to anyone interested in local history. It was formed in 1984 through the enthusiasm of a group of people interested in the area. Members can attend regular meetings and lectures, join outings to places of historical interest and enjoy Society publications.

There is also the opportunity to participate in personal or joint research with the support of other members and, by courtesy of the Town Council, members can make use of the town archives on Wednesday mornings. We arrange a number of evening lectures in Aylsham, often with refreshments beforehand from 7pm. The AGM is held on the first Thursday in October at 7pm, with the first lecture following it.

The Society produces three issues of the Journal and Newsletter per year which is sent out to members.
